

Pride Month





+TB Tests and HIV Testing

As you know, there's a strong link between TB and HIV, and it's really important that all patients who test positive for TB are offered an HIV test on or after the date they receive their positive TB result. The national target for this measure is 95% or higher, and Wyoming's performance for 2024 was 86%, so we have room for improvement. While the CDU TB team has requested HIV test results for positive TB tests for quite some time, HIV testing will be a key measure in our TB Evaluation and Performance Management Plan (EPMP) for the 2025-2029 TB grant project period. Please make sure that anyone conducting TB tests is aware of this requirement and ensures that an HIV test is completed on or after the date of a positive TB result. Your hard work and attention to this matter are truly appreciated.
