What are WylR reports?

Reports are a tool in the WylR that

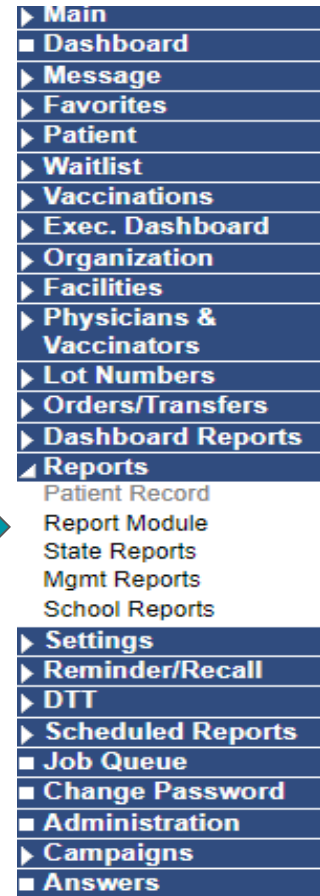
- Processes the data and information that meet the criteria of the report and search parameters selected
- Present the information in a useable format to assist providers, school nurses, and other authorized users to serve their patients and other needs

Ways to populate WylR reports



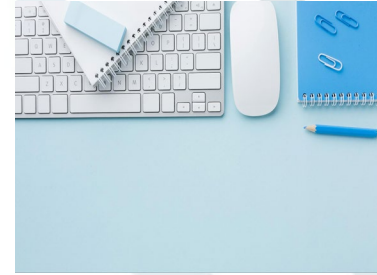
Ad Hoc

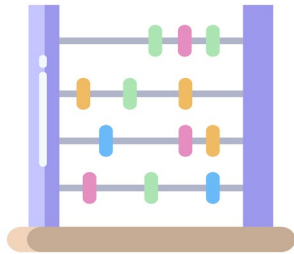

Vaccination Totals Report

- Number of vaccinations submitted, added, or updated for the selected organization
- Totals can be broken down for individual facilities
- Multiple vaccines can be chosen



This report can be helpful when summarizing vaccine doses recorded in the WyIR

Best practices when producing a Vaccination Totals Report

- Choose vaccine(s)
- Enter Vaccination Dates (range)
- Report can be run by *Total Vaccinations by Vaccine* , or *Total Vaccinations by Vaccinator*

- Number of vaccinations administered or recorded as historical for the selected organization or facility
- Date range on the selected vaccine



This report can be helpful when locating vaccine doses recorded in the WyIR

- Find discrepancies in inventory
- Determine how many vaccines have been given in a certain time frame

Best practices when producing a Vaccine Breakdown Report

- Choose a single vaccine rather than multiple
- Enter vaccination dates (range)

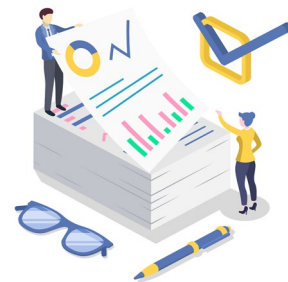
Lot Number Summary Report

- Current inventory counts
- Show where the inventory went
- Doses total, used, wasted, and available
- Multiple vaccines can be selected



Lot Number Summary (cont)

- Assist in correct decrementing
- Determine if transfers may be needed, or can be facilitated
- Assist in reconciliation
- Determine the vaccines administered to help with ordering



Best practices when producing a Lot Number Summary Report

- Enter the Lot Number of the specific vaccine you want to summarize
- Check *Subtotal by Vaccine* box

Lot Usage & Recall Report

- List of patients who have received a specific lot number during a specified date range
- Provides an option to mark all selected vaccinations as compromised so that patients can be recalled and revaccinated



Lot Usage & Recall Report (cont)

This report is helpful when determining lot numbers recorded in the WyIR

- Assist in correct decrementing
- Recalling patients that were administered vaccines that may have been invalid
- Assist in reconciliation
- Compare in-house records to WyIR records

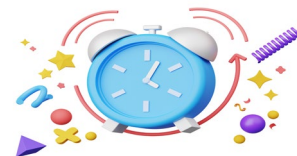

This report is helpful in determining daily inventory needs

- Aid in inventory discrepancies
- Plan for daily vaccination volume

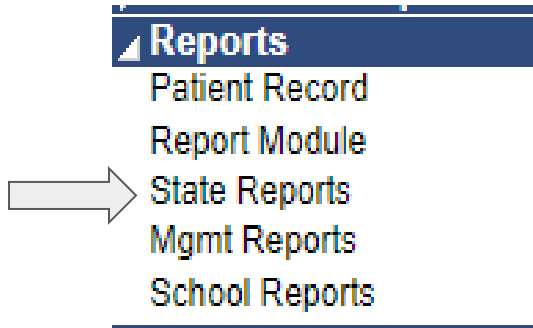

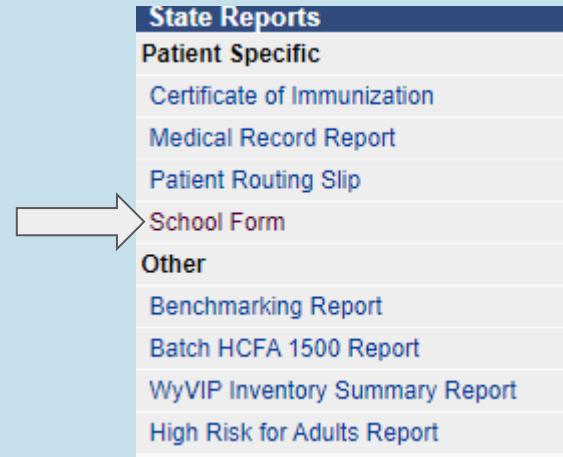

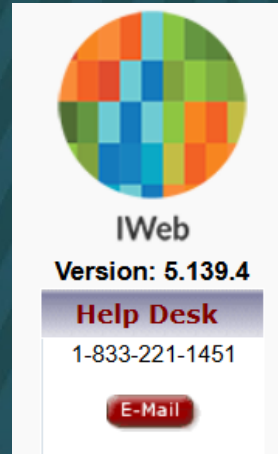
