Submission of Letters of Intent for Competitive
Older Americans Act Title III and Wyoming Home Services Grant
Lincoln County - Wyoming

Notice is hereby given that Letters of Intent to apply for the Older Americans Act (OAA), Administration on Aging Title III-E & Wyoming Home Services (WyHS) Programs for the Wyoming Department of Health, Aging Division, Community Living Section for services to be provided will be accepted until 5:00 p.m. MDT, **August 31, 2025** by the Wyoming Department of Health Aging Division, Community Living Section, 316 W 22nd St., Cheyenne, Wyoming 82002. The Letter of Intent shall be on the applicant's official letterhead and include, at a minimum, the name, address, email address and telephone number of the applicant agency, reference the Aging Division's grant, the type of funding source requested, the proposed types of services to be provided, and the Board chairperson's signature.

The OAA, Administration on Aging Title III & WyHS programs set out specific objectives for maintaining the dignity and welfare of older individuals and create the primary vehicle for organizing, coordinating and providing community-based services and opportunities for older Americans and their families. The goals of the Title III and WyHS programs are to focus on enhancing the lives of older individuals to allow them to remain in their homes, thus preventing inappropriate or premature institutionalization. The OAA, Administration on Aging Title III & WyHS Programs currently available in Lincoln County, Wyoming are: Title III-E National Family Caregiver Support Program, and Wyoming Home Services.

These programs are authorized pursuant to W.S. 9-2-1204 & W.S. 9-2-1208. The application will cover the grant period of October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026, for the Title III-E National Family Caregiver program; and October 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026 for the Wyoming Home Services program. The option of extension for these programs is subject to federal and state guidelines, and is not guaranteed. Contracts for these projects will be issued to successful applicants dependent and conditioned upon the federal budget authority, and quality of care provided to clients by the grantee.

A grant application will be emailed upon receipt of the Letter of Intent by the Wyoming Department of Health, Aging Division, Community Living Section and beginning after August 18, 2025. Grant applications will be due by 5:00 p.m. MDT on **September 12, 2025**. In the case that no applications are received, or no grantees have met the minimum requirements by the due date, the applications shall remain open for this service area until filled. At all times the Aging Division reserves the right to award zero funds for this funding opportunity.
