PUBLIC NOTICE Intent to Adopt New Rule Wyoming Department of Health

Public notice is hereby given that the Wyoming Department of Health, Division of Healthcare Financing, proposes to adopt the following new rule pursuant to its statutory authority in Wyoming Statutes §§ 42-4-101 through -124.

Wyoming Medicaid Rules Chapter 53 Home and Community Based Services Pilot Program

Chapter 53 establishes standards and procedures to conduct a pilot program to pay general fund financial incentive payments to providers and case managers who provide specialized transitional Home and Community-Based Services to clients transitioning from the Wyoming State Hospital to home or community-based living.

Currently, it is difficult to enlist providers and case managers willing to provide such transitional services. Additionally, the existing waiver system lacks the structure and resources necessary to manage such transitional services.

As required by Wyoming Statutes § 16-3-103(a)(i)(G), this proposed change meets minimum substantive state statutory requirements.

A public hearing will be held if requested by 25 persons, by a governmental subdivision, or by an association having not less than 25 members.

Written comments must be submitted to the above address or on the Secretary of State Rules website, no later than 11:59 p.m. on January 3, 2026.

Interested parties may request a statement of the Department's position regarding each comment and the action taken as a result of the comments prior to, or within thirty (30) days after the Agency action. Requests must be submitted to the above address. If requested, the statement will be issued by the Department within thirty (30) days after the Agency action.
