

Did you know there is help available to pay for mental health and substance use treatment services?

What is the Behavioral Health Center Benefit Plan?

The Behavioral Health Division contracts with Behavioral Health Centers around the State of Wyoming to provide outpatient and residential mental health and substance use disorder treatment services.

The Behavioral Health Center (BHC) Benefit Plan is intended to provide these comprehensive, state-funded treatment services to individuals who meet financial eligibility or fall into a priority population category.

Priority population categories are determined by a clinical diagnosis or a referral from one of our partner State Agencies.

How do I apply for the BHC Benefit Plan?

To determine your eligibility for a BHC Benefit plan, you must:

1. Complete and submit a Medicaid Application to determine your financial eligibility; and,
2. Meet the criteria for a priority population, determined by a clinical diagnosis; or,
3. Have a referral from a partner State Agency, school, therapist, or crisis center.

What services does the BHC Benefit Plan pay for?

If you are found eligible for the BHC Benefit Plan, services will be provided by your local Behavioral Health Center and may include:

- Clinical Assessments
- Case Management
- Individual Therapy
- Group or Family Therapy
- Psychosocial Rehabilitation Services
- Supported Employment
- Mental Health & Substance Use Disorder Residential Services
- Emergency Services
- Medication Assisted Treatment (for Opioid Use Disorders)
- Peer Support Services
