



## Specifications

- This report is based on claims paid through the Medicaid Management Information System (MMIS) through January 2026 for births occurring in the calendar year 2024.
- The calendar year 2000 - 2015 Medicaid data was generated from historical COLD reports O0210A, O0210B, and O0210D.
- The calendar year 2016 - 2024 Medicaid data in this report was generated from the Medicaid Data Warehouse. This report calculates births by unique recipient ID, unique date of service, and unique county.
- Data for Wyoming statewide births was supplied by Vital Statistics Services.
- This report includes the number of undocumented non-citizen births. These births are covered under the Emergency Services regulation that requires Medicaid to cover labor and delivery charges for undocumented non-citizens.
