Our Programs

The Older Americans Act Funds the following programs:

Title III-B Support Services – *Health services (health education, health exercise, preventative health), supportive services (chore services, counseling, crisis intervention, outreach), transportation services, and socialization services*

Title III-C Nutrition – *Home delivered meals, congregate meals, nutrition screening, assessment, education and nutrition counseling*

Title III-D Disease Prevention & Health Promotion – *The Title III-D, Disease Prevention and Health Promotion Program is intended to assist elderly Americans age 60 and older by removing barriers to independent living and adding to a continuum of care for vulnerable individuals to educate and implement activities that support healthy lifestyles and promote healthy behaviors.*

Title III-E Nation Family Caregivers Program – *Counseling, case management, PERS, homemaking, training, information, support, assistance, respite, personal care, and the Older Relative Caregiver Program*

The State funds the Wyoming Home Services Program:

Wyoming Home Services – *Care coordination, homemaking, personal care, respite, chore, adult daycare, Personal Emergency Response Systems (PERS), home modifications, and medication set up*
