

PRESM Provider Types

Individual: An actual person. Can be a Payto or a Treating provider if they are a case manager with an Individual NPI number. The provider must enroll with a social security number, but can add an Employment Identification number (EIN) if they wish to be paid to it. Prior authorization numbers (PAs) are issued to the individual.

Group: A case management business with an EIN and an organizational NPI that has enrolled case managers linked as treating providers. PAs are issued to the individuals.

Facility: A business with an EIN. Can be for Waiver only providers. Case management agencies with an organizational NPI should not register as a facility. No enrolled treating providers can be affiliated with a facility. PAs are issued to the facility.

PEM: Provider Enrollment Manager. Created by a person or business to enroll and manage more than 1 provider file.
