Wyoming Department of Health, Medicaid
Notice: High-Risk Provider Revalidation & Mandatory NPI Requirement

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In accordance with guidance from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS), the Division of Healthcare Financing (Division) is enhancing program integrity standards across all Medicaid programs, including State Plan and 1915(c) Waiver services.

Effective immediately, Wyoming Medicaid is initiating targeted revalidations and implementing a mandatory National Provider Identifier (NPI) policy across all provider types.

Providers identified as high-risk must complete a revalidation application no later than October 31, 2026. Additionally, all Wyoming Medicaid enrolled providers, regardless of taxonomy, are required to obtain a valid National Provider Identifier (NPI) and report it to Wyoming Medicaid. Providers who currently do not hold an NPI will be treated as high-risk until an NPI is on file, and failure to obtain an NPI will result in payment suspension and/or disenrollment. All active providers must ensure their NPI is added to their enrollment record on or before October 31, 2026.

Key Information & Requirements

- **NPI Requirement:** Every enrolled provider and rendering individual must obtain an NPI via the National Plan and Provider Enumeration System (NPPES) at <https://nppes.cms.hhs.gov>
- **Revalidation Deadline:** All affected providers must log in to the Wyoming Medicaid Provider Portal to complete revalidation and/or submit their NPI no later than October 31, 2026.

Impact of Non-Compliance

- **Disenrollment:** Providers who fail to update their record with an active NPI or complete revalidation by the October 31, 2026 deadline will receive a payment suspension, and face termination from the program on February 1, 2027.
- **Claim Denials:** Missing or inactive billing provider details after the October 31, 2026 deadline will result in claim denials.

Action Required & Support

- **Obtain an NPI:** Apply via NPPES if you do not currently have one.
- **Submit Revalidation:** For providers who need to revalidate, access the Wyoming Medicaid Provider Portal at <https://wyoming.dyp.cloud>. Navigate to your dashboard, select your revalidation application, and complete and submit it for verification.
